Clarification


Sub. : Regarding number of companions in the Cover of Reserved Category "A" – (70+ Applicants).

Clause ii) & iii) of Para 8.1 Reserved Category "A" – (70+ Applicants) of the Guidelines for Haj 1434 (H) – 2013 is further clarified as under :-

- 8.1 (ii)** One companion is a must for 70+ Pilgrims and no 70+ Pilgrim alone will be registered under Reserved Category.
- 8.1 (iii)** Only one companion is allowed who should be immediate relative namely Husband / Wife / Brother / Sister / Son / Daughter / Son-in-law / Daughter-in-law / Grand Son / Grand Daughter / Nephew or Niece. No other relation will be allowed to travel as companion.

From the above, it is clear that atleast one companion is a must for one or more than one 70+ Pilgrims in a Cover. If two 70+ Pilgrims want to take one companion each, it is also allowed.

The Companion, in his Affidavit, shall agree to take care of such aged Pilgrim/s and his/their belongings during entire Haj journey. Further, in any case, maximum size of the cover shall be 5 (Five) adults + 2 (Infants) only.
