

How to Apply Haj Seat under Government Discretionary Quota for Haj-2020

As per the New Haj Policy of Haj Committee of India for the period of next five years Haj-2018-2022, the Government of India retains 500 seats under Government Discretionary Quota comprising:

- (1) 200 Seats for the HCol (Haj Committee of India)
(NOTE: -These seats are recommended by HCol's Chairman, Vice-Chairman & Members only)
- (2) 300 for Govt. of India:
 - (a) Hon'ble President 100
 - (b) Hon'ble Prime Minister 75
 - (c) Hon'ble Vice-President 75
 - (d) Hon'ble Minister of Minority Affairs 50

“Government Quota can be released only to those pilgrims who have participated in the “Qurrah” but have not been successful and possess a cover number as proof of participation in the Qurrah.”

2. In this regard, it is to inform that the above Quota is disbursed by the above respective authorities directly, for which recommending/ forwarding of by Chief Executive Officer, Haj Committee of India is not required. Hence in view of the above, it is suggested to forward recommendation/ requisition letter to the above concerned authority directly with request on plain paper along with recommendation of the MP/MLA/ Others, if any.
