# Subject: Selection of 500 Pilgrims under Mehram Quota for Haj-2025

In reference to this office Circular No. 12 dated 25/11/2024, a total of 739 applications were received under the Mehram Category, out of which 711 applicants were found eligible. Since the number of eligible applications exceeded the available quota of 500 seats under the Mehram Quota, a Random Digital Selection (RDS)/Qurrah was conducted. The select and waitlist for Mehram category is now available on the Haj Committee of India

- 2. The selected lady applicants should deposit an amount of Rs.2,72,300/towards First and Second installments latest by 30/12/2024.
- Payments can be made either through:
- a. E-payment facility available on https://hajcommittee.gov.in or Haj Suvidha App using Credit Card / Debit Card / Net Banking /UPI

#### OR

- b. Specified Pay-in-Slip in any branch of State Bank of India or Union Bank of India in the account of Haj Committee of India using Bank Reference Number available on the website against respective cover number.
- 4. After depositing the specified amount, the selected pilgrims in Mehram Category must submit the following documents to the concerned State/UT Haj Committees latest by 01/01/2025.
  - Haj Application Form (HAF) a.
  - b. Solemn declaration and undertaking C.
  - A copy of Pay-in-Slip / online receipt
- Medical Screening & Fitness certificate (as per format available on the website)
  - Self-attested copy of machine-readable international passport
- The State/UT Haj Committees shall upload all the aforementioned documents on the web portal of Haj Committee of India immediately upon receipt from the lady pilgrims in Mehram category.
